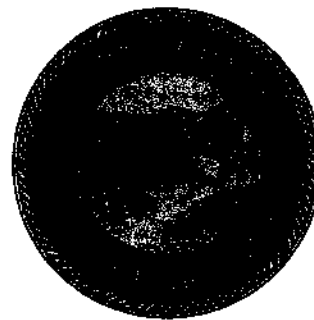
STAFF WAS GIVEN DIRECTION

Dear Mr. MacIlvaine:

The Kern River Groundwater Sustainability Agency (Kern River GSA) desires to participate in the Kern Groundwater Authority's (Authority) study titled "Remote sensing of historic (1993-2012) evapotranspiration using ITRC-METRIC for the valley portion of Kern County" according to following terms and conditions:

1. The Kern River GSA covers an area of 228,572 acres, and using the cost allocation methodology consistent with the Authority's Activity Agreement, will pay a pro-rata share of up to \$55,685 of the total estimated cost of \$295,000, for remote sensing data and maps.
2. All payments from the Kern River GSA shall be due 45 days after the receipt of data from the Authority.
